Discover why every Christian – no matter how ‘messed up’ – can find their freedom and become a fruitful disciple as you encourage them to understand their new identity in Christ, resolve their personal and spiritual conflicts and to be transformed through the renewing of their minds.

“The Spirit of the Sovereign Lord is on me, because the Lord has anointed me to proclaim good news to the poor. He has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim freedom for the captives and release from darkness the prisoners.” (Isa. 61:1)

Our hope is that this workshop will help equip, encourage and empower you to walk in the anointing that Jesus has already given you in Him and, in turn, help people fully resolve the deeper issues that they have.

WHO IS THIS FOR?

Those who, as a part of a team in their church, want to help people resolve deeper issues. Participants should have covered the basic FIC teaching and ideally have attended our *Transforming Discipleship* one-day event.

- Why Christians with deeper issues need to know what they already have
- How to equip them to win the spiritual battle and stand firm
- Understanding and assuming responsibility
- Why every Christian can become a fruitful disciple
- Using *The Steps Freedom in Christ* to resolve personal and spiritual conflicts
- Setting up a church team and tools to work with a deeply wounded person
- Understanding specific issues such as abuse, dissociative disorders and addictions
